CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrews, subject to modifications hereafter mentioned, together with such local rules as are in force on the courses over which the competition takes place.
- 2. The Match Committee will settle any dispute or protest.
- 3. The Match Committee will make all arrangements and has full power to alter or make any variation in the conditions, should it deem desirable, and shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person, without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 4. In any event, competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Match Committee may arrange, and it shall have the power to select a marker for any competitor whose fellow competitor is not at the appropriate tee at the appointed time to start.
- 5. Competitors must be ready at the appointed time, and if not at the appropriate tee when called are liable to be sent to the end of the field. Only in special circumstances, approved by the Committee, may competitors be permitted to start at a later time.
- 6. The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, either shorten or cancel any event.
- 7. Ties—All Individual Stableford Events shall be decided by a countback on the last 9 holes. If there is still a tie, then the last 6, 3 or 1 holes. If there are further ties, there will be a countback using the first 9 holes. For the Aggregate 36 Hole Stableford Event, the countback will be done on the last 18 holes. If there is still a tie, then the last 9 holes shall be used, then the last 6, 3 or 1 holes. If there are further ties, there will be a countback using the first 9 holes.
- 8. For the 36 Hole Aggregate Stableford Event, a competitor stays in their initial Division.
- 9. Players winning Major Trophies are <u>not eligible</u> for Down The Line Balls.
- 10. In the Four ball event, a competitor can only win one trophy.
- **11.** The Match Committee reserves the right to limit the capacity of an event.
- 12. Winners are asked to be present to receive prizes.
- **13.** Players scratching are asked to notify <u>the officials at the Club</u> where they are drawn.
- 14. Slow Play: Players are reminded that if they lose a clear hole on the group ahead of them they must let the following players through.
- **15.** The Match Committee has the right to alter the Conditions of Play before the start of the Competition.
- **16.** Single Entries for Stableford event are ineligible to win the Aggregate Event.

DRESS REGULATIONS

Suitable golfing attire to be worn at all times. Competitors are required to comply with the dress regulations of the Host Club.

HEAT POLICY

The Heat Policy will be implemented if conditions warrant.
